

# LIBERTY ACADEMY AT THE PRIORY FACT SHEET

### **OUR HISTORY**

Liberty Academy at the Priory is a church affiliated institution, which operates as an outreach ministry of Swallowfield Chapel. It was established out of the need for more Christian schools, which openly teach the Word of God. It commenced operation on September 5, 1994 on the grounds of Swallowfield Chapel, but was relocated to 66a Arnold Road in 1998. The school was later moved to 32 Hope Road in January 2003 and, renamed Liberty Academy at the Priory.

The High School Department was established in September 2007, in response to an outcry by parents, for an alternative High School Programme for secondary students.

The school currently offers a partially inclusive programme of education, catering to approximately 310 students between the ages of three and eighteen (18) years.

To be and make disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ using programmes of excellence through holistic development of students and stakeholders.

#### MISSION STATEMENT

A christian and mission focused, well resourced, and inclusive institution recognised for excellent academic and cocurricular programmes.

#### SCHOOL PROFILE

Liberty is a private Preparatory and High school, which enrolls students who are ages 3 to 18 years. The school facilitates students who work best in small class sizes (maximum 25 students). In addition, we pride ourselves in encouraging strong Christian values and developing healthy self-esteem through the use of music, drama and other extra-curricular activities. The school is conveniently located and the environment is therapeutic.

Liberty embraces students with varying abilities, and operates a partially "Inclusive Model of Education". Therefore, the school facilitates general education students, and also those who have Special Needs (e.g. Mild to Moderate Autism & Learning Disabilities).

The school offers a wide curriculum and addresses the overall development of the students by assessing their needs, monitoring their progress and adapting their programmes based on individual needs. This promotes excellence in academia, as well as, fostering the development of integrity, positive social skills, boldness, critical thinking, environmental awareness and awareness of the transforming power of God in their lives.

Currently, there are four departments:

- The Kindergarten Department
- The Junior (Prep.) Department
- The High School Department (Inclusive of the High School Enrichment & Resource Room Programme)
- The Special Needs (Prep.) Department

Liberty Academy at the Priory is a pioneer of 'Inclusive Education" in Jamaica.
